Setting the Standard Award

For leading by example while compiling impressive results

Agent of Change Award

For driving change and innovation, either within the organization or across the field

Inspiration Award

For inspiring the rest of us

Thought Leader Award

For offering bar-raising guidance and insight

Unsung Hero Award

For positively influencing an organization or the field from behind the scenes with a positive attitude, a willingness to help in whatever capacity necessary and a commitment to excellence

Industry Ally Award

(Must be aligned with Industry Ally track)

Elected official, high-level government administrator, trade group member, analyst, influential academic or researcher, other thought leader, etc.

Business Partner Award

(Must be aligned with Business Partner track)

Vendor/sponsor whose unique contributions have helped move the sector forward

*Vendors are eligible to enter in this category ONLY

Career Achievement Award

Recognizes a person who has made most distinguished contributions to the field over a lifetime of service

(Note: This category is not part of the regular nomination and judging process. Potential candidates will be gathered and considered by event leaders, who will determine one award winner each year. Only one award will be given annually.)

*Vendors are not eligible to enter/win this category



After entries are submitted, a panel of judges will begin a thorough review process.

Any juror who has a potential conflict of interest with a particular entry will not be allowed to judge that entry.

All jurors will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement that bans them from disclosing information from entry submissions.

Judges do not discuss their individual scores with anyone — not even with each other. As such, the winners are not known until honorees are announced in December. Only the highest-scoring nominees will be awarded as a winner. Note: This may mean that certain categories will not have a winner.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All nominations must be submitted by a peer, colleague or friend of the nominee. No self-nominations at this time.

All nominees should be actively involved in the field.

Vendors are eligible to enter only in the **Business Partner Award category**. Any entries in other categories will be disqualified.

Each entry must be submitted online. Once all entry information is prepared, entries can be submitted through the online submission portal. All entries must be submitted and paid for online. You may input your entry information and save as a draft to return at a later date to finalize or submit payment. Credit cards accepted include Visa, Mastercard and American Express. Entries that are not paid prior to judging will not be considered.

McKnight's reserves the right to publish information about the nomination if the individual is chosen as a Pinnacle honoree. If any information in your nomination must be kept confidential, please use the Confidential Information section on the nomination form, and only the McKnight's editorial team will see it. This includes the nominee photo.

All nomination forms must be submitted with a high-quality headshot of the nominee. All headshots should be color, at least 300 dpi and, preferably, professionally shot. Images should be no smaller than 3" by 3". File size should not be less than 300 KB.
